

# Mexico Mission Trip 2018

June 19-26, 2018



## Purpose

We will assist the Starlings with their ministry in Rancho La Paloma. We will experience mission work in villages, cities, and camp settings. We will also be doing construction work at the camp.

## Details

**Saturday:** Today will be spent shopping, sightseeing, dinner at the local steak house and then return to camp.

**Sunday:** Attend morning worship service at local church. Eat at Burrito Factory. Attend evening church at Emiliano Zapata.

**Monday:** Culture day! Tortilla Factory, testimony at Lupe's house, visit local cemetery, and mountain hike (those who do not want to hike may stay at camp and help with projects).
